In pursuance of the Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Proprietaries Warrant granted to John Shelby and Robert Smith bearing Date the 29<sup>th</sup> October 1772 resurvey'd the 23<sup>d</sup> March 1775 the above described Tracts of Land Situate in Peters Township in the County of Cumberland --- The Tract to John Shelby containing three hundred and eighteen Acres and sixty four Perches and an Allowance of Six ~~1/2~~ Cent for Roads &c and the Tract to Robert Smith containing three hundred and twenty five Acres thirty two Perches and Allowance as aforesaid.
