Report.

The above Tract is covered by the following Office rights to wit: The part marked **A** of 106 Acres 47^p & al. is wholly the same as a Tract Survey^d on the day of 1811 on Warrant to Adam Piper dated 13th June 1811 and held under said Title.

The part of the Tract marked **B** separate from the part **A** by a dotted line is included within the lines of a larger Tract of 349^a 84^p held or claimed under a Warrant to Frederick Stone dated 19th March 1794 - Note No evidence appears of possession in John Milsum or of any person claiming under his Order of Survey - Tho^s Reed, one of the joiners in Milsums Order, is not found - probably the Land survey^d on Stones Warrant; was that of Reed,
