Being part of three larger tracts originally Surveyed as above stated one in the name of Thomas Rush containing 446 acres and 67 ps & all. & c. one Tract in the name of Peter Shirley containing 442 ac & 19 ps & allowance & c and one Tract in the name of John Carver containing 429 acres & 133 perches & allowance & c. Originally Surveyed the 22nd day of May 1794 on warrants respectively dated the 18th day of March 1794.

N.B. the two tracts in the name of John Carver an. Peter Shirley Interfere with an elder Survey in the name of John Gibson 75 acres & all. & c.
