



A Draught of two tracts of Land Situate in Marlborough Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania, Being part of a tract at first taken up by Michael Reiber, Then sold by him to Philip Keyler who sold the same to John Alt and Henry Gabel, who sold the above two tracts thereof to Conrad Zimmerman ~

The first Beginning at a Stone a Corner of the said Conrad Zimmermans other Land, Thence by the same South West 42 perches to a post, set for a corner of George Breys Land, Thence by the same North West 32 perches to a post, and North 10^{degs} West 54 perches to a post, and North 35^{degs} East 40 perches to a post in the line of John Alt's Land, Thence by the same South 55^{degs} 25^{minuts} East 34 perches to a stone in the Line of Henry Gabel's Land Thence by the same South West 34 perches to a stone and South East 49 perches to the Place of Beginning Containing Twenty Acres and 102 perches with the usual allowance for Roads ~ The second Beginning at a Stone a Corner of George Brey's Land, Thence by the same North East 40 perches to a Stone, a Corner of another tract of the said George Brey's Land Thence by the same South East 52 perches to a post, and South West 40 perches to a stone in the Line of the said Conrad Zimmermans other Land. Thence by the same and by Land of Leonard Miller North West 52 perches the Place of Beginning, Containing Twelve Acres and 42 perches and allowance. Containing together, Thirty Two Acres and 144 perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per cent for Roads ~ Surveyed for the said Conrad Zimmerman on the 22^d Day of November Anno 1756,
