Warrantees above named. — in the year 1815. Resurveyed by Henry (abt.) ounel Esq. as appears from his works, under an Order of the Board of Property dated Feb. 10, 1815, and now to wit in the months of September & October 1829, pursuant to a special appointment, have Re-examined the survey and located the Warrants as above represented. —
