



A Draft of a tract of Land Situate in Lurgan Township Franklin County Containing Two hundred Acres & allowance of Six & Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 14th day of April 1819, in pursuance of an Order of the Honourable the Board of Property dated the 7th day of January 1819 Directing a Survey to be made for James Taylor in pursuance of a warrant granted Thomas Ruth for 200^o Dated the 4th day of March 1793 (Agreeable to its Location) In Executing the said warrant I find that it interferes with a survey made for John Maclay Junr on his warrant dated the 19th day of December 1785. The residue of said tract is laid down by dotted lines I have also laid down by Double lines a survey made for John McClay on his warrant Dated the 16th day of August 1754 for the purpose of shewing the Boundaries as called for in the warrant of John Maclay Junr.
