

A Draught of 18<sup>o</sup> 135 perches of land with allowance of 6 per Cent for Roads &c situate in Granville late Derry Township Mifflin County Penna Surveyed Nov. 16<sup>th</sup> 1830 and April 18<sup>th</sup> 1831 by Robert Robison D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant to William Brown for 20<sup>o</sup> dated May 15<sup>th</sup> 1830 Resurveyed & corrected April 8<sup>th</sup> 1834 for William Brown by David Hough then D.S.

Examined by running some of the lines & corrected Jan 11<sup>th</sup> 1853 to make the Courses conform to the true Bearings for Elias W. Hale Esq the present owner

David Hough late Deputy Surveyor of Mifflin County being duly sworn doth say, that while he was Deputy Surveyor of said County he was employed by William Brown Esq. now dead, to correct & return a survey made by Robert Robison, formerly D.S. (Surveyed 16 Novt. 1830 and 18 Aprl 1831) in pursuance of a warrant to William Brown dated 15 May 1830. Upon which he had surveyed & returned to the surveyor Ge! 64<sup>o</sup> 117 pr & gall and which was returned for correction, the warrant being for 20<sup>o</sup> and the amt. or number of acres surveyed And it being to great That deponent in his official capacity corrected said survey on the 18<sup>o</sup> April 1834, and immediately made a return thereof to the Surveyor Gen! That he examined the lines on the ground for said William Brown, and reduced said survey to 22 acres, a copy of the survey so corrected and return is hereto annexed. The fees were paid to deponent by William Brown. That John Shaw (afterwards Deputy Surveyor of Mifflin County) while he was Deputy Surveyor of said County informed this deponent that he the said John Shaw had seen said corrected survey, as returned by deponent, in the land office at Harrisburg.


