



Lewistown 2d March 1840.

Sir

I send you a rough Diagram of 4 Tracts or pieces of land No 1 is claimed on a Wt granted Robt Bochannon & Moses Williamson in Derry Township Mifflin County for 300 Acres dated 21st May 1793 And I find several drafts of the same piece of land in this office but none of them tells when the survey was made a copy of the Wt was put into the hand of Wm Shaw on the 22d August 1838 and he says that the owner ^{of the Wt} never set any time when he should make the survey Neither did he with me And on the 5th Sept 1839 George Brought put a Wt into my hand for 50 acres of the same Tract & on the 6th & 7th Sept I run the Bochannon & Williamson Draft but found no old mars after I left the Stone Corner of Abm Miller ^{until} I came to the BOK at the river No 2 represents the survey I made for Geo Brought - who has paid me for surveying But have not yet rec'd any fees for surveying the Bochannon & Williamson Tract - Broughts hands carried chain round both surveys - you will see by referance to the Bochannon & Williamson Wt that it can neither ~~be~~ Bound ^{on} Dan Jones or John Brown - I wish you to say how I am to return these two surveys I have not calculated either of them, it may be possible to include the vacant land up to the Mountain line there might be enough of land to fill both the Wts so far as the lines are dotted I had no line either old or new, the black lines on the Phillip Minehart Tract had been run about a year before I was on them
