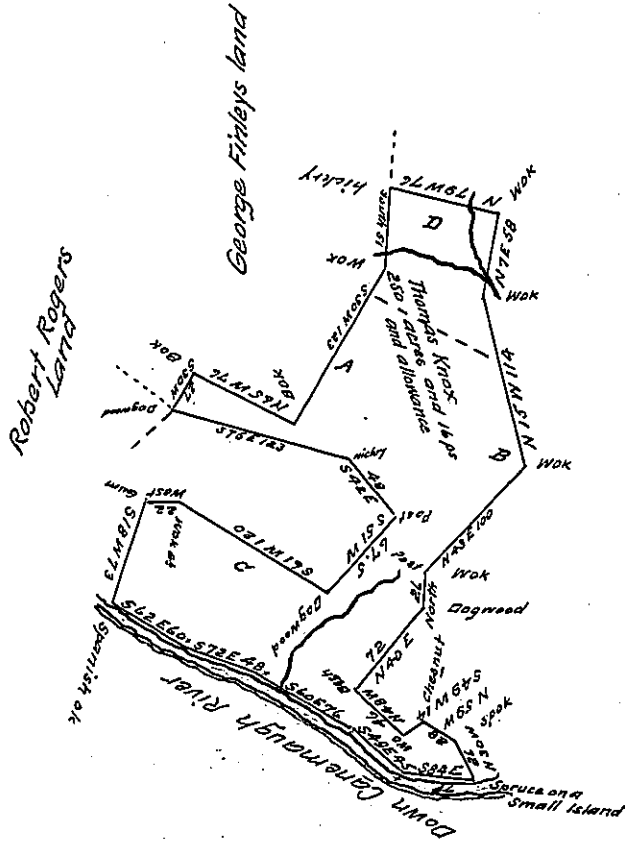

Survey'd for Thomas Knox on the 17<sup>th</sup> November 1795 the above described tract of Two hundred and fifty acres and sixteen perches and allowance of six ft Ot. for Roads &c including an improvement between Blacklick & Conemaugh adjoining or near lands of George Finley in Westmoreland County by Warrant of the 23<sup>d</sup> day of February 1785 by Alexander Taylor for James Ross Esq<sup>r</sup> late D.S. as appears by a Draught in my possession which I have examined & find correct
