A.D. 1856 In pursuance of two warrants No. 1 dated the 17th day of March 1849 which survey contains 99 1/4 acres & allowance, & No. 2 dated the 30th day of August 1856 which survey contains 53 1/4 acres & allowance, the 1st one granted to John Witt & Philip Wolfersberger for 100. as & the second one granted to Philip & David Wolfersberger for 75. as.
