November 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> 1857. Resurveyed at the request of Dr. Geo. L. Shearer, James Porter, Abram Mumper and Wm. Stover, the present owners, and at their request returned for confirmation To John Rowe Esq.
