



The above represents a Tract of Land situated in Montgomery Township Franklin County Containing Ninety seven acres and one hundred and and thirty nine perches and allowance of six $\frac{1}{4}$ Cent for Roads &c. which was formerly Surveyed and Patent to John Lelless on his Warrant Dated August 18th 1806. And part of said Tract Viz, No 1 Containing sixty seven acres and nine perches & allowance &c. since appears to be part of a Tract of 82^{ac} 114^{pc} & allowance which was Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to a certain Daniel Davies Dated June 1th 1763. (and the remaining part of said Davies survey Interfered with an Older survey of Francis Johnston's.) Nos 2 & 3 Containing Thirty acres and one hundred and thirty perches and allowance &c. appears to be clear of any prior right than said Lelless Warrant. Resurveyed August 7th 1810 for Jacob Leiter in persuance of an Order of the Hon^{ble} Board of Property of Penn^a Dated May 24th 1810.
