Containing 544 acres 167 perches with the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c (being one of the Tracts within the Boundaries of a large survey made for George Croghan May 22^d 1766. by Robert M^r Kensie under Richard Tea D.S. Resurveyed 4th Day of September 1797. on Warrant granted to Christian Snyder Dated June 1st 1763.
