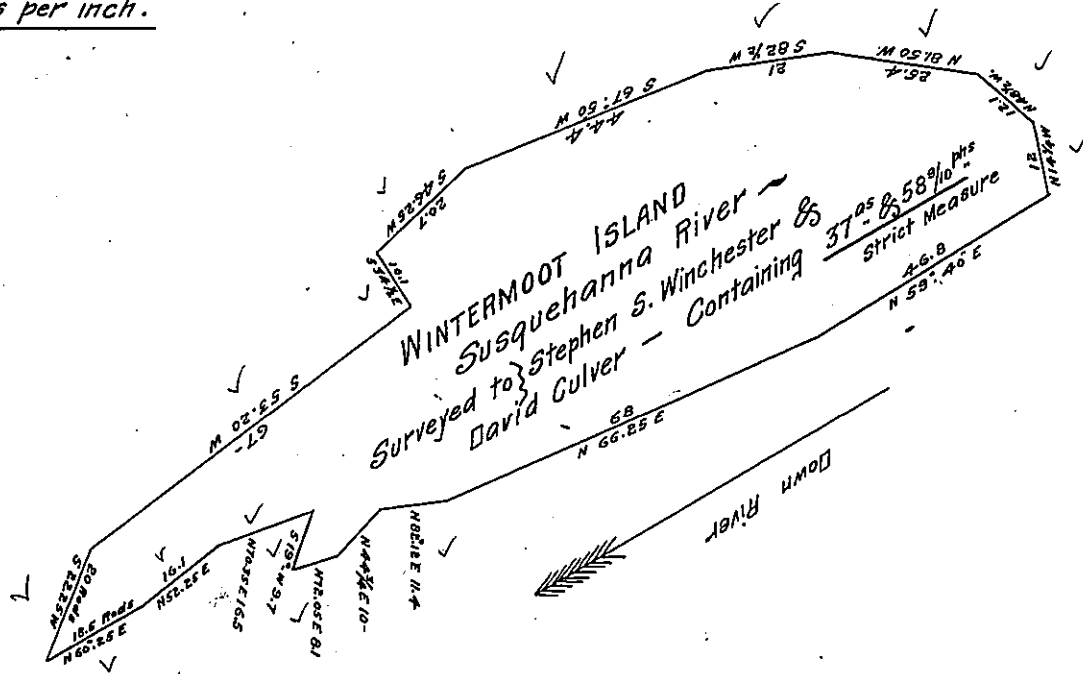


SCALE: 25 Rods per inch.

Surveyed the above Island to Stephen S. Winchester and David Culver, in pursuance of their Warrant dated Oct. 4<sup>th</sup> A. D. One thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy (1870) - Surveyed Oct. 8<sup>th</sup> (1870) one thousand eight hundred and Seventy.
