



Pursant to a Warr from Edward Penington then Surveyr Generall bearing date the 9th day of the 4th mo. 1701, directed unto me I do certiey into the Generall Survey^r office Now at Philadelphia that I have Reasurveyd the 20th of the 2nd mo. 1702: unto Gunn's Runbo a Certaine tract of land on the west sid- of Scoolkeel- being within the bounds of Leticia Penns Marner beginneing at a whit ok being a corner deviding it from Peeter Goke land from thence by a line of marked trees and ye same land East north east 712 perches to a Hickry marked by Scoolkeel River from there by the severall Courses of ye same 238 perches to another corner Hickry marked deviding it from the Widdow Yeecurns land from thence by a line of marked trees and ye same land with the land of John Hugh West south west 544 perches to a blak ok marked deviding it from the said John Hughes land from there by a line of marked trees deviding it from same other part of the said Marner north north west 150 perches to the plac of beginneing Containeing six hundred and fourteen acres of land and is according to the bounds above described Return'd into ye abovesd offic- the 18th day of the abovesd 2^d mo. —
