E. into ye woods 640 Perches to a marked oke and from thence Running E. b. N. 30 Perches to a marked poplar standing in Stone Creek from thence a Long the Creek upon severall courses to a marked Gumme from thence N. W. b. N. 168 Perches to a marked Red oke from thence S. W. b. W. 590 Perches to a red oke standing by Grum Creek from thence a long the Creek side upon severall Courses to ye first corner tree.
