



Whereas the severall persons herein mentioned Have Requested us to grant unto them a Proportion of ye bank of Philadelphia on Delaware River side wee have granted ye same as hereafter followeth that is to say unto Charles Pickerin Thirty ffoot, unto Chris Pennock Thirty three foot, unto Thomas Duckett thirty ffoot, unto Melisent Hodgkins Thirty ffoot, unto W^m Southby Thirty ffoot, unto W^m Baldwin Thirty three foot and to Mary Sibthorp Thirty three foot and likewise unto John Simcock ye bank before his ffront Lott being one hundred and two ffoot, and unto Andrew Robinson ye bank before his ffront Lott being one and fifty ffoot.

These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto each person aforementioned their said quantity of Bank, between ~~the~~^{Saxafrae} Street and Vine Street. And whereas there is a lott between ye two Streets aforesaid w^{ch} was formerly layd out as ye Purchase lott of Thomas Bracy quantity one hundred and two ffoot ye w^{ch} Lott ye said Bracy Exchanged with ye Proprietor ffor a tract of land at Chester. Therefore thou art Required to survey or lay out ye said bank before ye said lott viz one hundred and two ffoot and Reserve ye same ffor ye Proprietarys use or till further order, of all which thou art to make returne to ye Secretarys office.
