E. 36 perches thence S. 50 E. 88 perches thence S. 28 E. 36 perches to a Hickry marked being a corner deviding it from Owen Roberts land from thence by a line of trees and same land west south west 124 perches thence west 12 degrees south 56 perches to a poplar marked thence west 9 degrees north 28 perches thence west 4 degrees south 80 perches then by the same land and y^e land of Robert Roberts west 15 degrees & 30 minit south 518 perches to a stak set in y^e ground being a corner deviding it from the said Robert Roberts land from thence north 18 degrees west by a line of marked trees deviding it from Robert Owens land 160 perches to y^e place of Beginning containing 679 acres of land and is according to the bounds above described
