By virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries to me directed bearing date the 31st day of December Anno Domini 1733 To survey or cause to be surveyed to the proper Use and Behoof of the 5^d Proprietaries The tenth part of all lands that after the date of the said Warrant should be surveyed within the several Counties of this Province. I have caused to be surveyed ^{on the 10th day of June A.D. 1734} for the use aforesaid A tract of land situate in the County of Bucks adjoining to Perkasea Man^r. Beginning at a Post in a Line of the 5^d Manor at a corner of James Logan's land thence by the same South West two hundred & nine perches to a black oak at a corner of James Robinson's land thence by the same north west two hundred & twelve perches to a post, thence by the same Land south west two hundred and fourteen perches to a post Thence by land of Henry Walmsley north west three hundred & thirty perches to a black oak thence by the same Land south West one hundred & seventy three perches to a post at a corner of William Briggs's Land, thence by the same north west fifty three perches to a post, thence by the same land south west one hundred & sixty perches to the line dividing the Counties of Philad^a & Bucks thence along the same north west four hundred & seven perches to a post in a line of William Allen's land, thence by the same & vacant land north east seven hundred & fifty six perches to a black oak, thence by vacant land south east thirty seven perches to a black oak a corner of the Manor aforesaid thence continuing the same course by the 5^d Manor nine hundred & sixty five perches to the place of Beginning Containing three thousand and eighty four acres and the Allowance of six acres & Cent for roads & High Ways Returned into the Secretary's Office the 28th day of February A. D. 1734.

This Tract is since returned to Tho. Frearrie by a special warrant a small part thereof only excepted.

By virtue of the warrant afores^d I have caused to be surveyed on the 11th day of June 1734 for the use aforesaid A tract of land situate in the Township of Montgomery in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a marked Hickery at a corner of a tract of land late of Richard Hayes, thence by land possessed by John Morris north east four hundred & sixty perches to white oak in the County Line afores^d thence along the same north west three hundred & thirty four perches to a post, thence by land formerly reputed Robert Astetori south west four hundred & sixty perches to a post, thence by the Land formerly of Richard Hayes afores^d south east three hundred & thirty four perches to the place of Beginning containing nine hundred & five acres and the Allowance of six acres & Cent for roads &c. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 28th day of February A. D. 1734.
