By virtue of a warrant from ye Proprietary and Govern<sup>r</sup>. Bearing date ye 29<sup>th</sup> of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo 1683, directed to me I hereby certify into his Secretaryes office that I have caused to be surveyed and laid out ye 1<sup>st</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> mo 1688 unto John Green Three hundred acres of land in ye County of Philadelphia, being his Purchase of ye Govern<sup>r</sup>. here. Beginning at a corn<sup>r</sup> post standing in ye line of Matthew Perwins land thence south west by a line of trees two hundred pches thence south east by a line of trees Two hundred and forty pches to a corn<sup>r</sup> oak saplin thence north east by Springfield Marour Two hundred pches thence north west by a line of trees Two hundred and forty pches to ye place of beginning containing Three hundred acres. And is accordingly Entered and recorded in my office at Philadelphia ye 18<sup>th</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo 1688.
