Surveyed for Everard Bolton a tract of land beginning at a stacke ^{by} standing ^{by} a large white oke tree marked for a corner, thence by the land of Mr^s Browne, S.W. 480 perches to a stacke marked for a corner, thence N.W. 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ perches to black oke sapling marked for another corner, thence N.E. 480 perches to a stacke standing on the east side of small run, from thence S.E. to the first mentioned place of beginning of 100 Acres.

Surveyed for ^{John} Ashman a tract of land beginning at a stacke standing on the east side of a small run thence S.W. 480 perches by the land of Everard Bolton to a black oke sapling, thence N.W. 83 $\frac{1}{3}$ perches to a stake standing by a gum tree marked for a corner thence N.E. 480 perches to a stake standing about 2 perches northward of a black oke marked for a corner thence S.E. to the first mentioned place of beginning of 250 acres.

Surveyed for Tobias Leach another tract of land beginning at a stake standing by a ~~white oke~~ large poplar tree thence S.W. 480 perches to a stake near unto a black oke marked for a corner thence N.W. 67 perches to a stake standing about 2 perches S.W. of a small hickory tree marked for corner thence N.E. 480 perches to a stake in a Low Valley thence S.E. to the place of beginning of 200 Acres.
