



Warrant of Resurvey

2d Novem, 1767

Robert Owens and others to
include certain vacancies
Called the "Bear Garden"

In pursuance of the several Acts of Assembly directing the recovery of the principal and interest to the Commonwealth from persons holding lands by virtue of locations or other Office titles issued from or under Proprietary Government and for other purposes, I have this day located and resurveyed warrant of resurvey granted to Robert Owens and others on lands in Conowago, Berwick and Mount Pleasant Townships, Adams County containing about 700 acres, and have found the interferences as represented in the enclosed diagram. Witness my hand.
