



The part marked A is an interference of a tract of 317 as 17 ps & allise sur'd on Warrt to John Downey for 300 as dated June 4th, 1792, now owned by J. Downey's heirs.

Part B is an interference of a tract of 172 as & allise sur'd on warrt to James Agnew for 200 as dated Jan'y 9th, 1786, now owned by Robert Douglass.

Parts C & D were sur'd on warrt to John Leatherman dated March 7th, 1750 & contain 9.50 as & allise also now owned by Robert Douglass, and all situate in Hamiltonbarrn Townp, Adams County  
 Jan'y 24th, 1838. Jno L. Gubernator.
