William Penn Absolute Prop^r and Govern^r in Chief of the Province of Pennsylvania and Counties Annexed.

At the request of Katherine Relict of Swart Swanson, Ann Relict of Andrew Swanson and Lydia Relict of Nolle Swanson. That I would grant them a Parcel of Meadow and Cripple lying between their plantations at Wickakoe and Hollanders Creek or as much thereof as is necessary for the Accommodation of their sd Plantations. These are to require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed to the sd Katherine Ann & Lydia the sd Meadow and Cripple or as much thereof as is necessary as aforesaid, and make returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand and seal at Philadelphia the 6th of 8th 1701.
