



Articles of Agreement Indented made & agreed upon this 12th day of the 3^d mo 1732 Between Thomas Wynn of Blackley Co. yeoman and W^m Couch of the same place Cordwainer Whereas Thomas Wynn & John ap John^{both} of the Kingdom of Great Britain did formerly purchase of W^m Penn proprietary & Governour of the province aforesaid certain Quantities of land in the said province in right of w^{ch} purchase there still remains 24 acres of Liberty Land untaken up w^{ch} doth of right appertain to the aforesd Thomas Wynn party to these presents Now it is hereby Governanted & agreed by & between y^e s^d parties And the s^d Thomas Wynn for himself his heirs Exec Adm^{rs} doth hereby grant bargain & sell to the s^d W^m Couch his heirs & assigns all his right to the s^d 24^a of Liberty Land & all warrants evidences & writings touching or concerning the same to hold to the s^d W^m Couch his heirs & assigns forever And the s^d W^m Couch for himself his heirs ex. & Ad. doth Covenant promise grant & agree to & wth the s^d Thomas Wynn his heirs & Assigns by these presents that he the s^d W^m Couch his heirs or assigns shall & will truly pay or cause to be pd to the s^d Thomas Wynn his heirs ^{for & in consideration of y^e sum of 30 lb to be pd to the s^d Thomas by s^d Couch as herein after declared} ~~the s^d sum of 20 lb~~ on y^e day next ensuing y^e date hereof And the sum of 6. 13 - 4 more thereof & ~~provided always and it is hereby declared to be y^e true intent & meaning of the s^d parties~~ And that the s^d Thomas his heirs &c. shall & will be at y^e request Cost & Charges of the s^d Couch &c. ⁸⁶ ⁰⁰⁰ ⁴ ⁵⁸ ⁵²

And it is hereby further Governanted & agreed by & between the s^d parties And the s^d Thomas Wynn for himself his heirs &c. do(obl) Covenant &c. to wth s^d Couch(obl) that if the s^d land be not laid out ^{within y^e space of 12 moe hence next ensuing} to the satisfaction & content of s^d Couch that then & in such case all the above covenants shall from thence forth become null void & utterly extinct to all intents & purposes. And the s^d Thomas Wynn shall & will pay or cause to be paid to the s^d W^m Couch the sum of 10 pounds.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this
