



Situate in Franklin Township Adams County Containing 7<sup>a</sup> & alls all (except the piece marked A containing 61<sup>ps</sup>) being part of a larger tract of land of 267<sup>a</sup> & 96<sup>ps</sup> & alls Surveyed by William Matthews D.S. Anno Domini 1765 for Thomas Hosack previous to the running of the manor (which was in the year 1766) when the part here laid down was cut off and surveyed by me Feb 27 1801 for Thomas Gilchrist the present owner

N.B. the triangle marked A containing 61<sup>ps</sup> was not included in Matthews's survey although it then belonged to Thomas Hosack nor was the piece marked B but the piece marked B was since patented by the proprietor and the land adjoining on every side is patented except the piece I have laid down.
