



Situate in Schuylkill Township, Schuylkill County, on the Waters of Big Schuylkill, Containing 616 as. 2 p. & allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Surveyed on the 17th day of August A.D. 1830, by virtue of a warrant granted Francis Parvin Junr. dated the 18th day of September A.D. 1751. Surveyed by Geo. Bahn. To the Honorable the Board of Property of Pennsylvania.

Actual Survey

The lines on the ground of the above survey shew to have been made in the year 1751 or early in 1752. No Draught to shew the date of the original survey.

Present owners

Jacob W. Seitzinger and Company who reside in Reading

The improvement on it was commenced somewhere about 31 years ago. A reviving Warrt. was granted on an original Warrant which John Penn original Proprietor of Pennsylvania had granted to a Mr. Horst in England some time in the year 1682 by virtue of which the above tract was surveyed sometime between 1780 or 1790 & returned but the survey was accepted only on condition that if the land had not been previously surveyed or appropriated. Order of Survey dated Sept. 1774. John Thompson.
