perches to a Corner post being the Corner post of Richard Lumdys Land thence South East by the s^d Lumdys line 8
of marked Trees 132 perches to a Tree being the Corner Tree of John Reynolds Land thence by the line of s^d John
Reynolds land South East 352 perches to a Corner post being the Corner post of Francis Houghts Land thence thence
