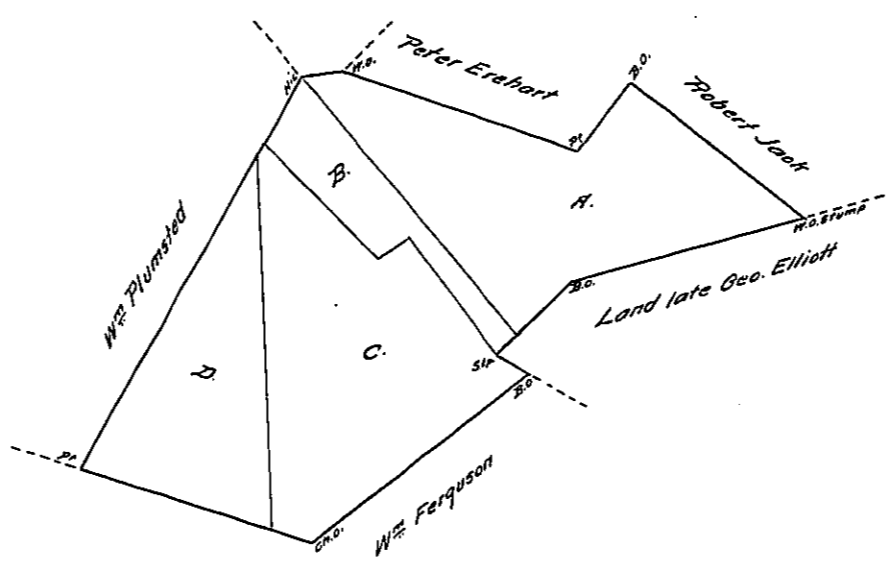

The above Black lined figure represents the lines of a Tract of 241 acres & perches and allowance, Situate in Hamilton Township Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) which was originally surveyed for the heirs of Wm Plumsted, and returned to the Land Office as per List No. 1 of the unpatented Lands.

Note, The part of the above Tract marked, A. has been surveyed and returned on a Warrant to Samuel Dryden dated 27 February 1786.
 The parts of the same marked B. & C. has been covered by a Warrant to Samuel Dryden and Owen Aston dated 2^d of Dec^r 1792.
 The part marked D. has been included with other Land on a Warrant to Edward Crawford acting Executor of John Brown Dec^r dated 2^d June, 1826. and confirmed by Patent.
 Note, The parts A. & B. have been patented to Wm Snyder Adm^r of Michael Doyle Estate in June 1829 on a Warrant of acceptance on the original Survey of Plumsted.
