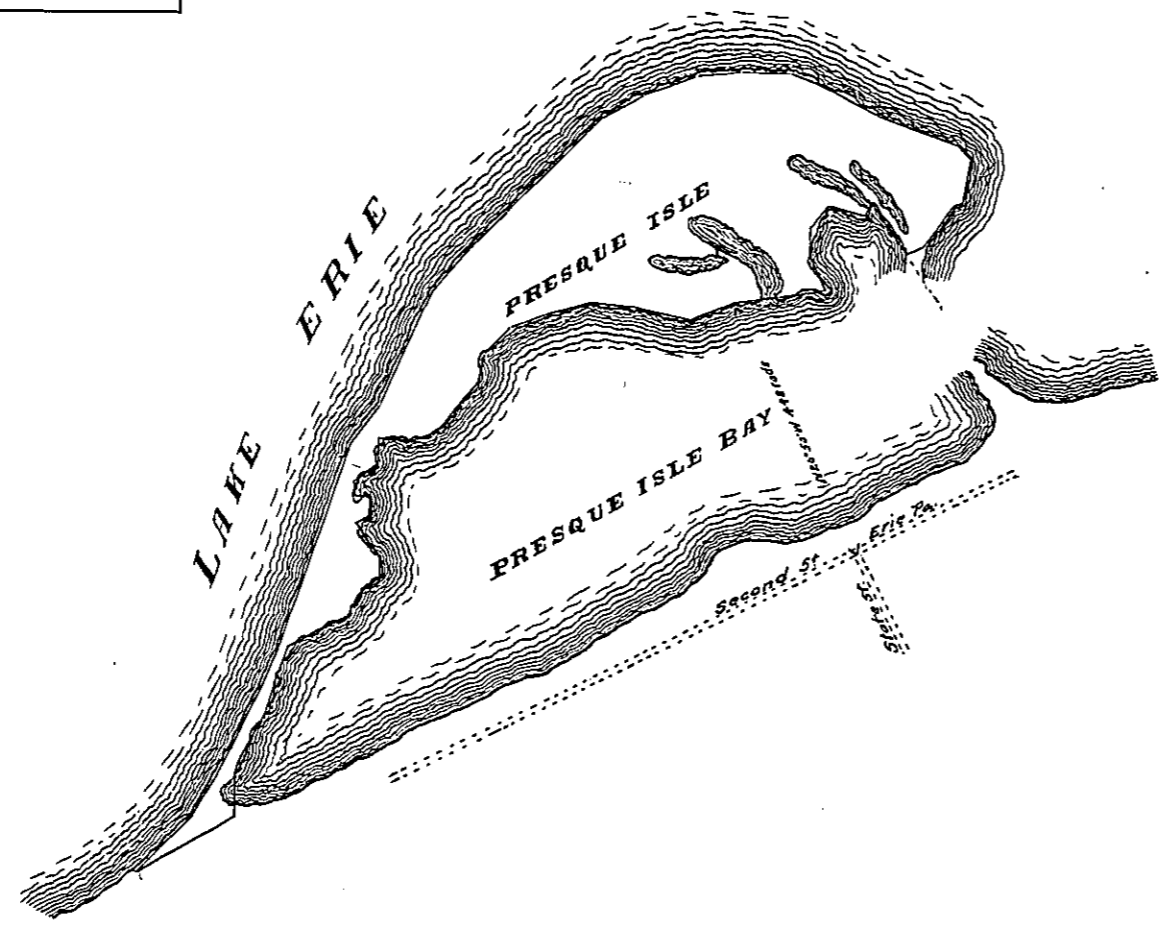

Erie Pa. April 15th 1869

To the Hon Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania

Below please find the field notes and a plot of the Peninsula lying to the Northward of and enclosing the bay of Presq Isle in the County of Erie State of Pennsylvania and attached at its western extremity to the Township of Mill Creek. Beginning at a point North 26°50' West 443 rods from the North line of Second Street at its junction with State Street in the City of Erie Thence S. 67°45' W 784 rods by the first course in the list. Thence by the courses & distances there given to the place of Beginning. Containing Two Thousand and twenty four (2024) acres of land as surveyed by me in March 1869
