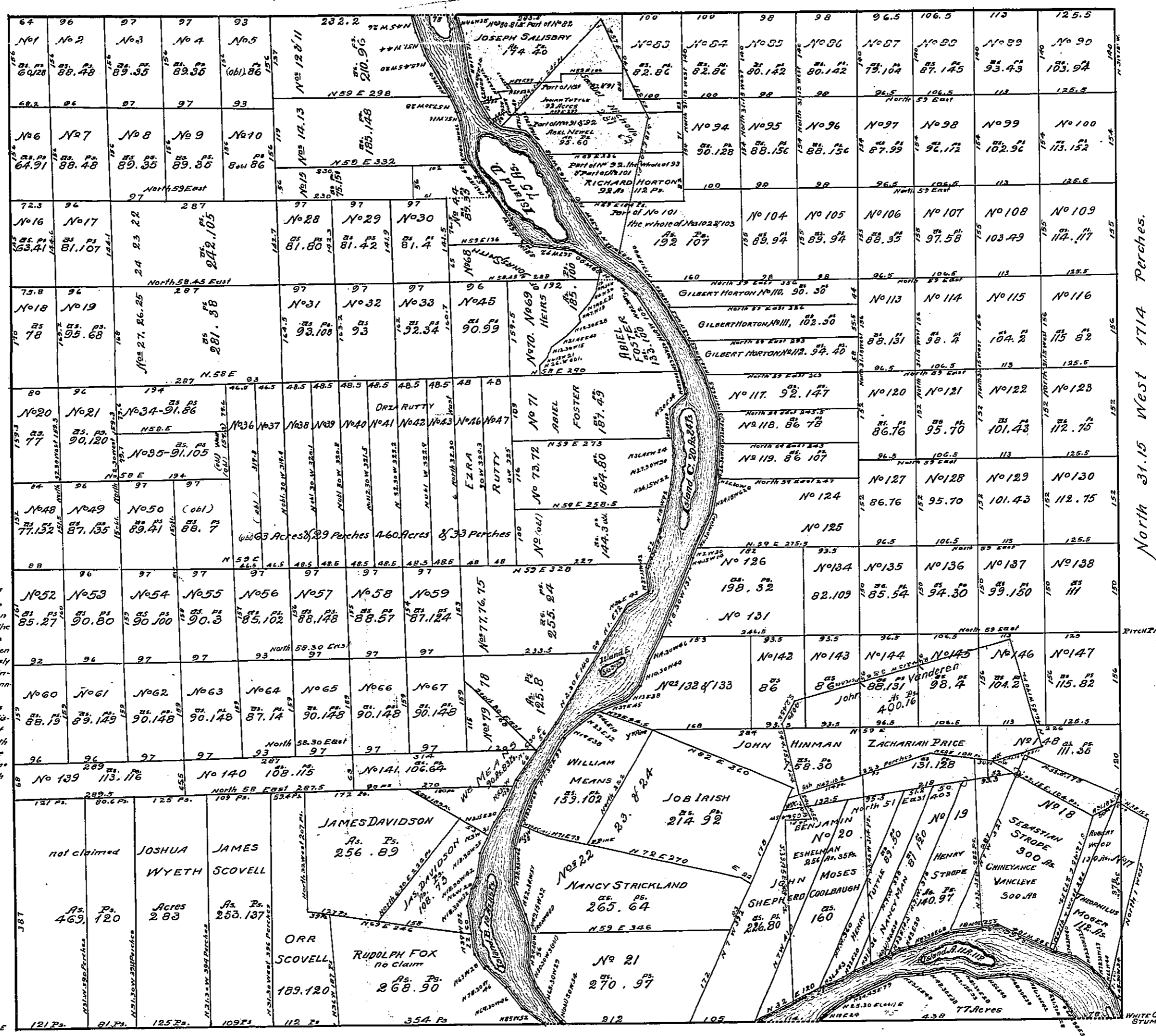


South 59 West 1872 Perches

ANNEXED is a DRAUGHT of a tract of land situate in Claverack - one of the seventeen Townships in LUZERNE COUNTY being containing twelve thousand, three hundred and twenty-eight acres and fifteen perches with the usual allowance of six per centum for roads, resurveyed for John Shepherd the tenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three, by order of the Commissioners appointed to put in execution an act of the General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania entitled "An act for offering compensation to the Pennsylvania Claimants of certain land within the seven townships in the county of Luzerne, and for other purposes therein mentioned."
