The above is a plan of the Honble Proprietaries Town of BEDFORD situate on the South side of the Raysstown branch of Juniata River in the County of Cumberland in the province of Pennsylvania surveyed and laid out on the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th & 14th days of June 1766, in Pursuance of an order from His Honor the Governor to me directed, bearing date the 5th day of May 1766⁰⁰¹

The lots are Laid out 60 feet front by 240 feet Deep except the Eight short Lots adjoining the Center Square which are 60 feet front by 120 feet Deep. The Depth of the Lots bounded by the Water are Various.
