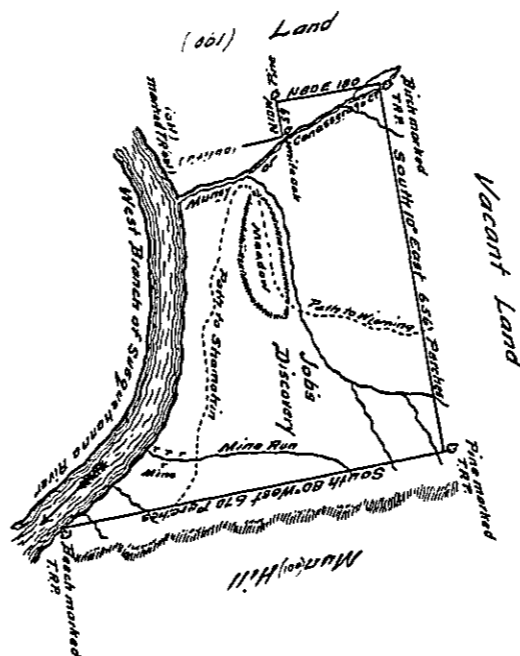

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 24th Day of November 1768. Surveyed the 26th & 27th Days of December 1768 for the use of the Honorable the Proprietaries of the Province of Pennsylvania, the above described Tract of Land situate on the West Branch of Susquehanna River at the Mouth of Muncy alias Connosarago, alias Ococh-pacheny Creek, containing one thousand six hundred & fifteen Acres with Allowance of Six Acres P.Cent.

Returned into the Secretarys Office the 8th of February 1769. [1769]
