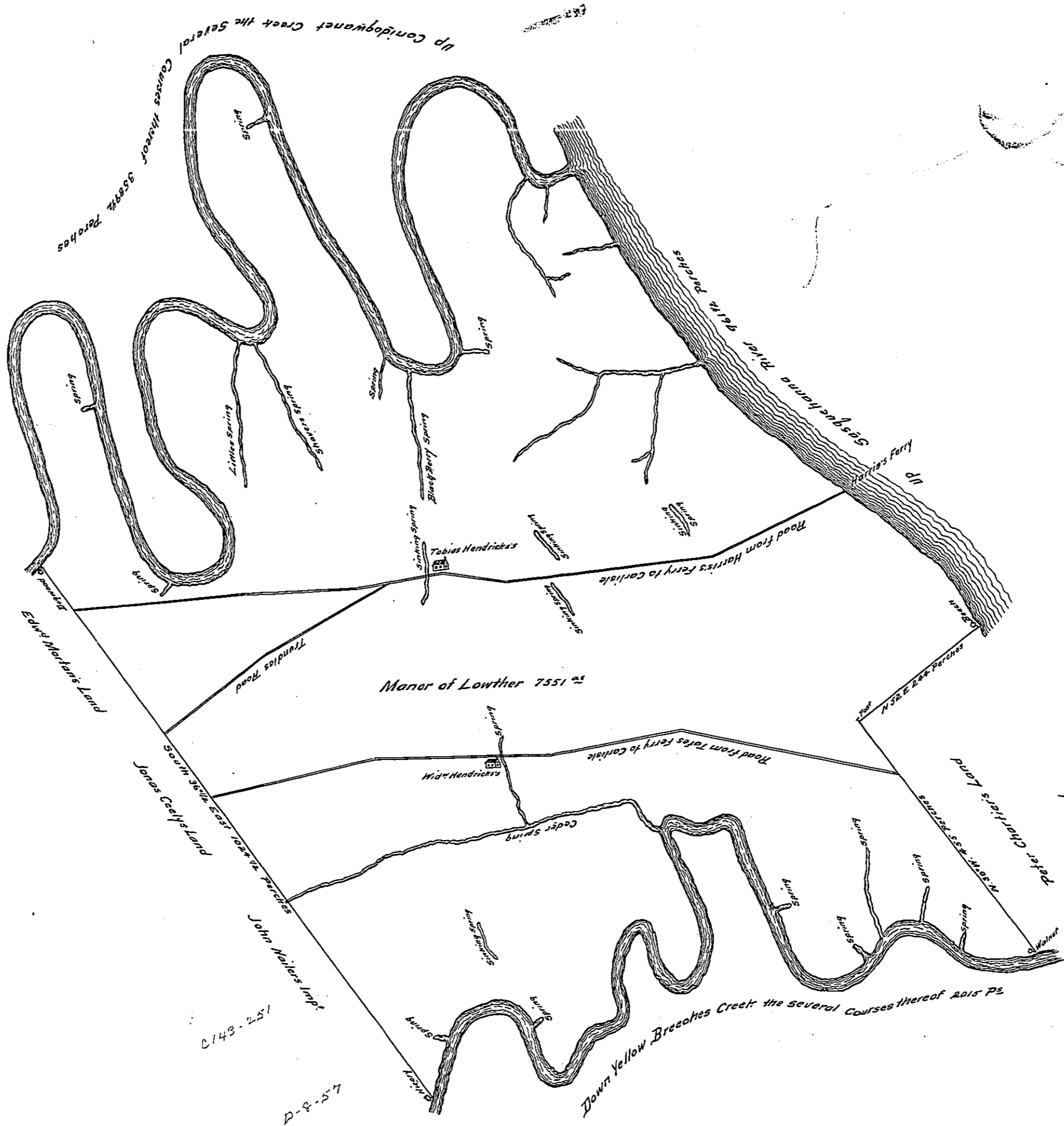

A Draught of a Tract of Land known by the name of the Manor of Lowther Situate in the Townships of East Pennsborough & Allen, in the County of Cumberland: containing Seven thousand Five hundred & fifty one Acres, and the usual allowance of Six P. Cent for Roads and high-ways; Resurvey'd for the use of the Honourable the Proprietaries in March, one thousand Seven hundred & sixty five, in pursuance of their Warrant of resurvey, bearing Date the Twenty sixth day of December, in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred & sixty four.
