

In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3d of July following of a certain bot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland being numbered in the general Plan of said Town, Seventy three, and granted to William McCord containing in Deugth, East West two hundred and thirty feet and in breadth North & South fifty seven feet Dix inches bounded Westward by the Broad Way fronting the River Sueque han na, Northward by Barberry Alley, Eastward by River alley & Southward by Lot No. 74 are by the General Plan of st Town remaining in the Surveyor General's Office will appear

for Lukens Surveyor Gen.
