



Situate in Franklin township Fayette County on the waters of Redstone Creek, Surveyed 22nd day of March 1839 in pursuance of a warrant granted John M. Austin for 200 acres dated the 25th day of January 1839 Improved, & 2 families residing thereon, and 50 or 60 acres cleared. The above is a Survey made by my predecessor Wm. Colvin and entered in this office. I return it as I find it entered at the request of John M. Austin Esqr. who thinks it has not been hitherto returned. I have not tabled it.
