



The above is a Draught of a tract of Land Surveyed April 26th 1813, in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Dawson, dated the 27th day of February 1813, Situate on the South side of the Ohio River on Mill Creek, formerly in Second moon, now in Green Township, Beaver County, adjoining Lands of Robert Laughlin, William Laughlin, Thomas Smith and others, Containing 161 acres & 1140 perches & allowance of Six percent &c.

To Andrew Porter Esq } I do hereby officially certify &  
 Surveyor General } make known that, at the time of  
 surveying & marking out the above described tract of Land,  
 viz on the 26th April 1813, The above mentioned James Dawson was  
 actually residing thereon with his family, that he had a dwell-  
 ing house fit for the habitation of man erected thereon, that he had at  
 least twenty acres of the said cleared and fenced, and was enga-  
 ged in cultivating the same.
