



Situate on the old rod leading from Bedford to Pittsburg now in Jenner township Somerset County (late Cumberland Bedford County) the original 318<sup>ac</sup> allowance Surveyed 18<sup>th</sup> September 1770 for Stewart Rowan Senr. in pursuance of an Order No. 406 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April 1769 by Thomas Smith Esquire then Deputy Surveyor - The above 141<sup>1/2</sup> a & all was Surveyed 20<sup>th</sup> May 1815 by John Wells Esqr. D.S. as appears by his official Draught remaining in my office & is now returned for a Patent to issue to Joseph Miller who will comply with the act of 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1820 by Executing a mortgage to the Gov. for the use of the Commonwealth - Certified 30<sup>th</sup> March 1824
