



Situate on the waters of Frankstown branch of Juniata adjoining the Old Gap tract of the London Land in Allegany Township Huntingdon County containing <sup>Four hundred & five acres & Forty three perches</sup> ~~405 as. 43 ps.~~ & allowance of Six ps. bent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 20th of October 1796 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Robert Alcorn dated the 2<sup>th</sup> of February 1796.
