

Surveyed the above described tract of Land the 11th April 1837 for James Armstrong & Anson V Parsons, by virtue of their warrant in right of an improvement for 300 acres dated fifth December 1834 Containing three hundred & twenty three acre & one hundred & fifteen perches, with the allowance of six percent &c Situate in Chapman Township Lycoming Co. on the North side of the West Branch of the Susquehanna River, below Young Woman's Creek & bounded as above -

Note - the improvements are about two acres cleared Land & a small Log House now in ruins.
