



A Draught of a tract of Land Situate on ten mile creek Washington County called Greenland containing two hundred twenty one acres & forty two perches and the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads Surveyed by John Hoge Esqr. Late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a Warrant granted to James Kerr for 240 acres dated July the 28th 1785, which original survey contained 225 1/4 acres & allowance and on Examination was found to include Land within the Patent lines of William Montgomery, which part is excluded from the above and both surveys correspond so far as they are adjoining done at the request of James Kerr Examined and certified to be correct this 22nd day of November A. D. 1802
