



A Draught of a Tract of land Situate in New-  
 bury Township in the County of York Resurveyed the  
 24th day of May 1794 by the lines formerly run In Pursu-  
 ance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Oates Dated the  
 25th Day of August --- 1753 containing in the whole one  
 Hundred & Twenty five acres and allowance of Six acres  
 bent for Roads &c. A. B. The part where the letter B is  
 placed Contains Twelve acres Three Quarters and Twenty  
 one perches Strict Measure which is added to the part  
 where the letter A stands as being part of the Original  
 Survey but now sold to the Canal Company
