



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town No. 52 Situate on the South side of High and to the Westward of Pitt Street, containing in Breadth East and West on High Street ^{Sixty feet} and in Length North and South two hundred and forty feet, Bounded Northward with High Street aforesaid, Eastward with Lot No. 60, Southward with a Twenty feet alley, and Westward with Lot No. 44 - Returned into the Secretarys office the 26th day of May 1772 for John Boyd.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of July 1903
