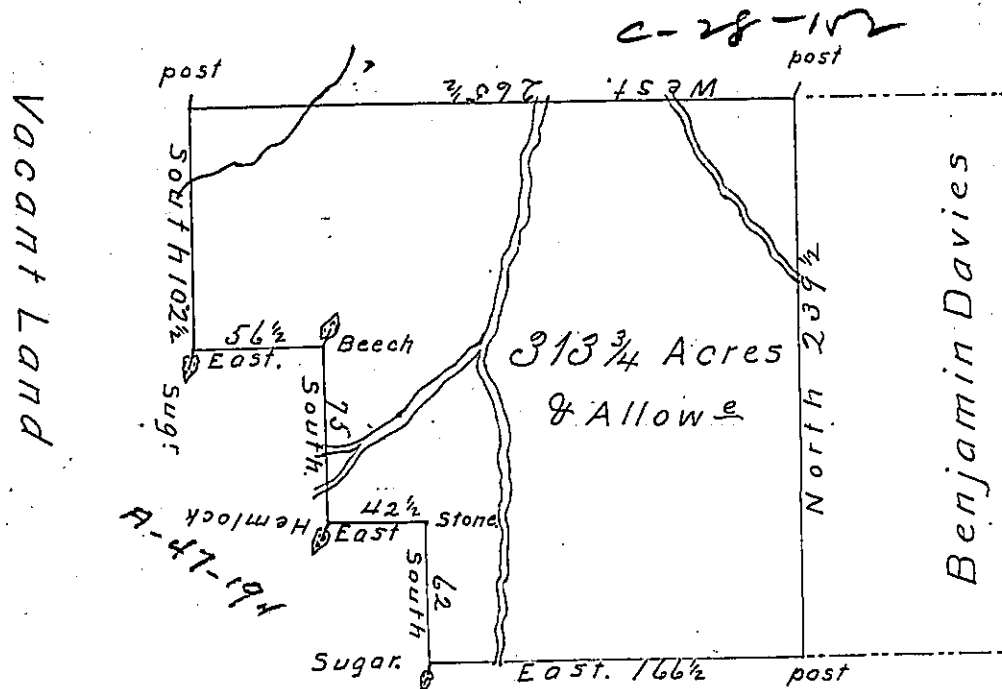


VACANT LAND
