



Situate in Patton & Halfmoon Townships, formerly Mifflin & Huntingdon, now Centre County containing four hundred and fifty Acres 120 perches and Allowance of six per cent. Surveyed the 8th day of September 1797 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Michael Kuhns dated the 27th day of December 1792. taken from the Notes of Jos. Wallis then Deputy Surveyor, and part of the lines on the ground examined by me the 20th day of July O.D. 1819.
