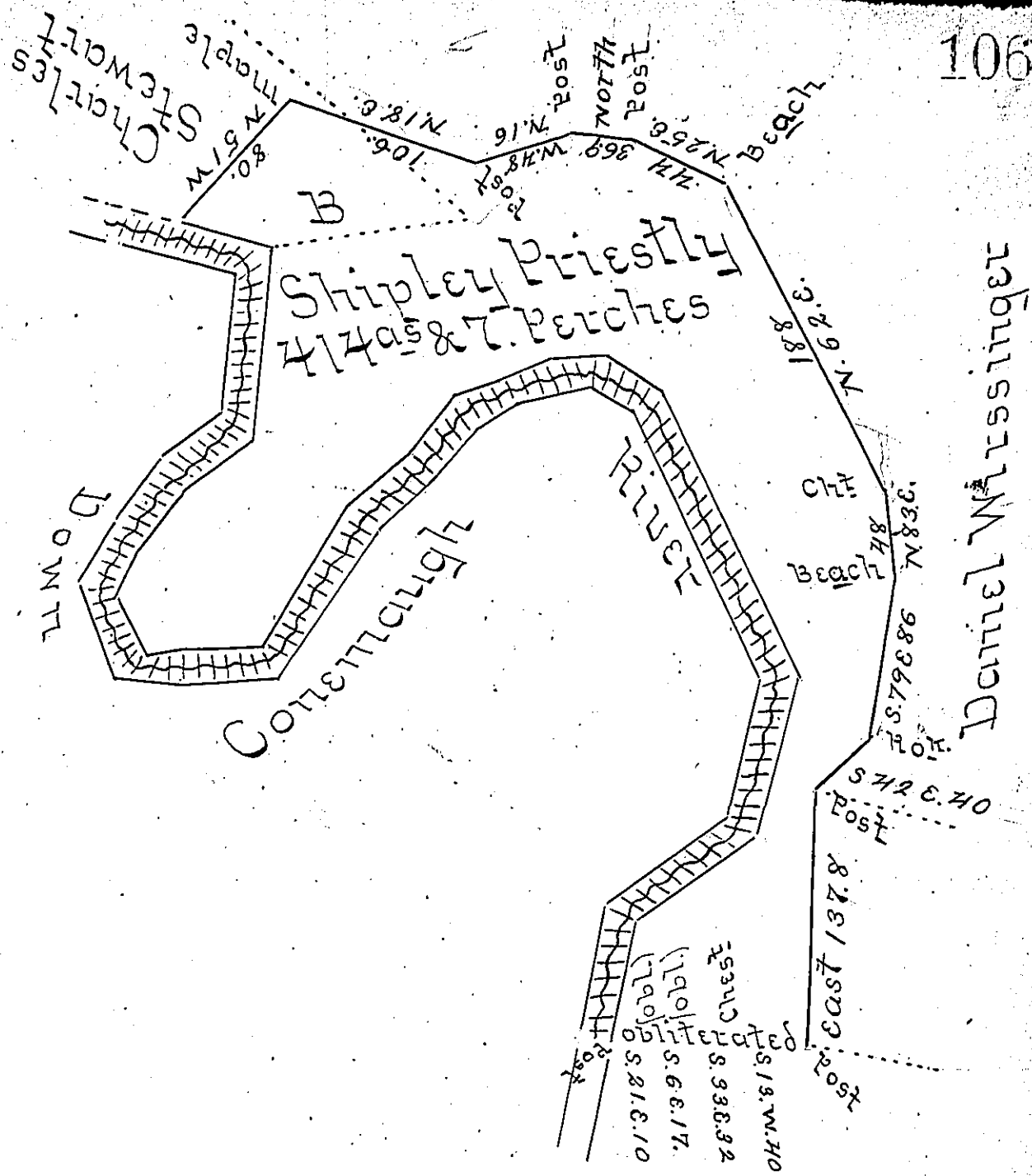

Situate on the South Side of Conemaugh River in Conemaugh Township Cambria County Containing 4149s & 7^{ths} with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed and corrected on the ground in August 1841 and found all the above lines well marked at the date of the original survey except along the River but the Courses did not agree with the Official Copy of Draft as will be seen, Resurveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated 2^d December 1830 granted to Shipley Priestly, the part marked B Shows the interference with C.S. Stewart
