9th of May AD 1850 Surveyed to William Haddon Senr the above described piece of land containing twenty three acres and thirty seven perches & Allowance of six per Cent situate in Green Township Indiana County adjoining his other lands and lands of John Huffnagle and Samuel Moorhead & others By Virtue of a Warrant granted to the aforesaid William Haddon Sr the 2th day of January AD 1850

MB I have examined the papers and cannot find any draft or Warrants referred to in Haddons Warrant he has a deed of Conveyance for his land adjoining the above (but neither course nor distance is given) which appears to be referred back to John Crawford as the Warrantee who the Warrantees of the others are I can not tell I was informed that there was a tenant on John Huffnagles land and that he Huffnagle resided east of the Mountains perhaps has his draft with him we found the two parallel long lines of the above especially the Huffnagle line well marked & old and made the survey without drafts
