



The above described Tract of two hundred and two Acres & one hundred and seven perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c is a part of two Tracts to wit. No 1 is part of a larger tract of 145 a qrs & al situate in Peters Township formerly Cumberland now Franklin County which was surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Armstrong bearing date the 15th of June 1752. No 2 is a part of a larger tract of 237 Acres 121^{ps} & allowance which was surveyed in pursuance of an Order of Survey granted to William Armstrong bearing date the 20th of August 1767 No 7311. Resurveyed and divided off from the other part of said Tracts for Alexander Mc Dowell the 5th of December 1822.
