



The above described Tract of ninety one acres and twenty two perches and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. is part of a larger tract of 257 Acres and 121 perches & Allowance. Situate in Peters Township, Franklin County (formerly Cumberland Co. Pa.) which was surveyed the 30th of October 1767 in pursuance of an Order of Survey granted to William Armstrong, bearing date 20th of August 1767 No. 4311. Resurveyed and laid off the above part for Jacob Leiter the 8th of December 1822.
