Within the black lines, it being a larger Tract of Land containing 367^{as} 10^{prs} & all surveyed in Pursuance of an order ^{No 2521} dated 3^d of April 1769 and a part of the same ~~the~~ land containing 510^{as} 3 1/2^{prs} & all surveyed 30th June 1815 for Robert Reed and Returned to the Land Office of Penna as part of the Land surveyed on said order &c. Situate now in Ligonier Township formerly in Fairfield Township Westmoreland County.
